

## Examination Module

### Class Pre-Nursery to Class – II

- There will be continuous evaluation of the performance of the child throughout the year in the form of assessments.

### Class III to VIII

There shall be two Subject Evaluation Tests (SET) and two Periodic Tests (PT) for these classes during the session beside half yearly Exam (HYE) and Annual Examination (AE). The syllabus for every exam/test will be intimated to students prior to their exam / test.

- **Weightage shall be as follows :-**
  - Average of SET and PT will be given 10% weightage in both HYE & AE
  - 5 marks have been allotted for subject enrichment activities and 5 marks have been allotted for quality of written work, timely submission and upkeep of the copies. These marks are also a part of the internal assessment marks.

### Class IX to X

- Annual Board exam of 80 marks based on 100% syllabus.
- Apart from this, three periodic exams to be conducted as follows:
- Periodic Test I of 40 marks is based on 25 % of the syllabus.
- Half yearly Examination of 80 marks is based on 50% syllabus.
- Periodic Test II of 80 marks is based on 75% Syllabus.
- Average of the best two of above three will be carrying a weightage of 10 marks in the final score. 5 marks have been allotted for subject enrichment activities and 5 marks have been allotted for quality of written work, timely submission and upkeep of the copies. These marks are also a part of the internal assessment marks.
- Grades will be given for co-scholastic areas like sports, art education, work education and personal traits like discipline, punctuality, attendance, behaviour etc.
- There will be two Pre- Board Examinations of 80 marks each before the Annual/ Board Examination for both IXth and Xth.

### Class XI and XII

- For Class XI, two Quarterly Tests, HYE and AE will be conducted.
- For Class XII, two Quarterly Tests & HYE will be conducted.  
Three Pre Board Examinations will also be conducted prior to the Board Examination.

All examinations are compulsory for all students. Satisfactory written explanation for absence has to be given to the class teacher, failing which a student will be marked zero in that test. Absence will be considered valid only on submission of a medical certificate to certify his / her illness issued by a registered medical practitioner.
